STUDENT DRIVERS POLICY



PURPOSE

This policy sets out our school's approach to students driving to and from school and school events. Our school recognises the need for the whole community to make efforts to minimise the risks associated with young drivers and to encourage responsible driving behaviours for students.

SCOPE

This policy applies to all students at Beechworth Secondary College who have a valid driver's licence.

POLICY

Our school recognises that some students will turn 18 and obtain a driver's licence while they are still attending school. Some of these students will want to drive to and from school. Beechworth Secondary College expects that all student drivers will adhere to the conditions of their licence and the road rules and will drive in a safe and responsible manner. If the school becomes aware that a student driver has driven in an unsafe or irresponsible manner, police will be notified.

Students are not permitted to drive themselves to and from camps, excursions or other school activities unless previously arranged and agreed in consultation with the school Principal or Assistant Principal, and only in exceptional circumstances or in circumstances where all students are required to make their own way to the event. Consistent with Victoria's Graduated Licensing System conditions, students are permitted to drive only one peer passenger (aged 16-22), unless the passengers are siblings of the driver.

Whenever a student in intending to drive themselves then a **Student Driver Agreement** must be completed and signed by their parent/carer. Where a sibling is a passenger in the vehicle, they must be named as a passenger in the agreement.

If the peer passenger is not a sibling of the driver then that passenger must complete a **Passenger Agreement** and have this signed by their parent/carer.

Students are not permitted to use their car during the school day unless it is for an approved reason such as an unavoidable medical appointment. A certificate of attendance at the appointment and Parental consent to leave school grounds are required. Approved reasons DO NOT include visiting private residences, going to the shops, leaving grounds during study periods or lunch and recess breaks.

If students act in breach of this policy, parents/carers will be notified and appropriate student sanctions will apply.

Beechworth Secondary College takes no responsibility for damage to vehicles parked in the student car park and parking is at the vehicle owner's own risk.

Parking

Students may park in the main school carpark, in rows adjacent to Balaclava Road.
